The Annual Meeting for the Carter Plantation Community Association was held Thursday, January 9, 2020

The two Board Members elected to replace Kevin Grace and Andy Turcotte are **Sherrill Pearson** and **Robert Logan**. *Many thanks to Kevin and Andy for stepping up and donating their time to help make this community a wonderful place to live*.

The 2020 budget was presented, voted on, and approved.

<u>ANNUAL MEETING HI-LIGHTS</u>

A 10 year Lease Agreement was signed between Carter Pines Properties L.L.C. (CPP) and the Carter Plantation Community Association, Inc. (CPCA) on 12/19/2019, to begin on January 1, 2020.

This agreement leases the property where the pool is located for the purpose of renovating and maintaing the currently existing pool facility, and construcing and maintaing a playground, sports court(s), and a community garden.

The following improvements will be made at the CPCA's expense:

- 1. By December 31, 2020, Pool Improvements, including resurfacing pool interior and the surronding surfaces.
- 2. By December 31, 2021, Playground will be constructed.
- 3. By December 31, 2022, Multi-purpose sports court(s) facitily to be constructed to accommodate basketball and volleyball activities.
- 4. By December 31, 2023, Community Garden will be constructed.

The CPCA will pay no rent to CPP until 2024. The rent shall be equal to 12% (3% for each of the above projects) of the collected annual assessments the CPCA receives from its members for the year 2024, and annually thereafter.

CARTER PLANTATION FITNESS CENTER



A 6 year Lease agreement was signed between Carter Conference Center L.L.C. (CCC) and the Carter

Plantation Community Association, Inc. (CPCA) on 12/19/2019 to begin on January 1, 2020. CCC will complete all the work necessary to accommodate a gym facility, and the CPCA will complete the furnishing and outfitting of the gym facility.

The CPCA shall pay no rent to the CCC until 2024, and at that point, the rent shall be 3% of the collected annual assessment the CPCA receives from its member for the year 2024, and annualy thereafter.

As of this writing, the equipment has been delivered. The fire marshal must approve the facility before the card system can be activated. The gym rules are being formed, and the Opening Date and Access Informaion will be released soon.


CPCA POA DUES

She underwent Immunotherapy cancer treatment for the next two years. Twice a year, she would return to Carter Plantation and stay with her sister, Carolyn, who had moved to CP right after Evelyn moved to North Dakota. On those occasions, she would visit with her friends and family that lived around the Springfield area. Unfortunately, Evelyn passed away at the age of 83 on January 12, 2020.



Historic Carter House Society Inc. (HCHS) Memberships

It is time for membership applications to be completed for 2020 in the Historic Carter House Society Inc. (HCHS) and those who have been members should be renewing theirs. If you are not a member, we ask that you join and help us with our Mission. Please see Mission Statement below.

Annual dues are \$30.00/individual or \$40.00/family, and the membership form to be completed is attached. Please return it to the HCHS; all the instructions are on the form. Membership dues make up a significant portion of the revenue for the HCHS, and will help the HCHS Board plan restoration projects for this year. As with any old house, there is always a possibility that something unexpected will arise. Below is a list of a few of the projects that need attention this year:

- 1. Carter House Locate/repair roof leak and repair damaged plaster
- 2. Guest House Install separate Entergy electric meter for Guest House
- 3. Carter House Remove damaged shutters, repair or replace, paint and hang with new hinges/clips
- 4. Guest House Repair swimming pool
- 5. Carter House Inspect/repair what appears to be a hole in corner of soffit on front porch
- 6. Guest House Build closets in bedrooms (2)
- 7. Carter House & Guest House Remove dead tree in front yard, and trim limbs hanging over the roofs of both buildings
- 8. Carter House Repair electrical outlets in kitchen & others not working, Safety Factor
- 9. Carter House Troubleshoot why ceiling fans do not work on front porch, replace if necessary
- 10. Carter House Inspect/repair bathroom window for leak/rotten wood, repair if necessary
- 11. Carter House Replace broken tile in the cross walkway by old fountain area, Safety factor

As a member, you will receive a discount off the Facilities Rental Fee published rate should you schedule an event at the Carter House. The form for that is on the website. Members also receive free admission to Open House events, and an important one is the *Christmas Open House*.
