- 1. The Golf Course is going through a \$10K \$20K maintenance upgrade.
 - a. Dead trees removed.
 - b. Upgraded Landscaping on the Patio.
 - c. Replace Clubhouse fans on patio.
 - d. Bar area will be remodeled.
- 2. Saints were here last month, and the Pelicans will be coming in September.
- 3. On Fridays, Saturdays & Sundays, they will open the refreshment stand behind the pool on Hole 10.
- 4. Pizza Oven will be installed. They will once again have a *Pizza Night*, and they may start home delivery of pizza in the neighborhood.

CPCA Accomplishments for the Year

- 1. Front Pillars and Pillars at Snowy Egret, cleaned and painted.
- 2. LED lights added at the trees on Carter Cemetery Road.
- 3. Fairway Garden Drainage and Landscaping underway.
- 4. CPCA/CDD Joint Venture streets cleaned 2Q19.
- 5. CPCA/CDD Joint Venture to replace all existing street signs. Order to be placed in July.
- 6. Gym Still ironing out details 99% complete.
- 7. Level Homes Working with them to become more compliant to PC&R's. They are now putting trash containers and screens on each lot under construction. Level has 18 lots left, 20 already SOLD.

Enforcing Rules

The board sent out 15-20 violations letters during the last 6 months. All of the violations were corrected after receipt of those letters. The main violations are for high grass, boats in driveways, and keeping kids play equipment out of view.
