Veterans Host Honor Guard Benton Thames



Local area Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 1052 were recently honored to host **Sgt. Benton Thames**, a **resident** of Carter Plantation and local businessman, who served as an honor guard for the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, which is located in Arlington National Cemetery. According to the recent article in the Hammond *Daily Star*, VVA Chapter #1052 and its auxiliary are very proud of Sergeant Thames' accomplishments and service to the country.

Soldiers are selected from the 3rd U. S. Infantry Regiment, which is also known as "The Old Guard" during a very selective process, and go through vigorous training.
