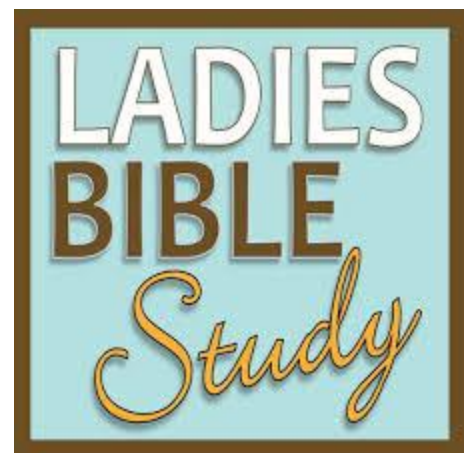


This year, our *Trunk or Treat* for Halloween will be held **before** Halloween night on **Saturday, October 27th**, and will be located on **Monarch**
