

# STREET REPAIRS, FIRE HYDRANT FLUSHING

Curing of the concrete should be complete and all barricades should be removed by Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>, for Phase 1 of the street repairs scheduled by the CP Community Development District. The temporary entrance at the end of Wild Iris Way will be closed and removed once that happens. Once more funds are available, Phase 2 is planned for next year to address some of the less critical street issues. Staining of the area at the Guard House exit will be done soon.

Please remember that most of the streets within Carter Plantation are considered public roadways, and fall under the highway rules and regulations of the State of Louisiana. Those rules do NOT permit the use of golf carts without headlights, tail lights, etc. required of vehicles that operate on public roadways in the state. Any golf carts used on the streets, except at designated crossings, are required to be registered with the state and have insurance. All operators must have a driver's license. Should an accident occur, the owner and driver could be cited, and uninsured carts operated on public streets will not be covered by insurance.

Fire Hydrant flushing is complete, and repairs to one hydrant and a street valve were done during that work. The hydrant painting should resume soon, weather permitting, and an alert will be issued at that time. The CP CDD Board of Supervisors wishes to thank the Livingston Parish Fire District #2 located in Springfield, and our water and sewer operators for their work on this project. Flushing and hydrant testing will be done annually in the future according to Fire Chief Brian Drury. This flushing and testing helps to maintain our fire rating that keeps our fire insurance premiums relatively low.
